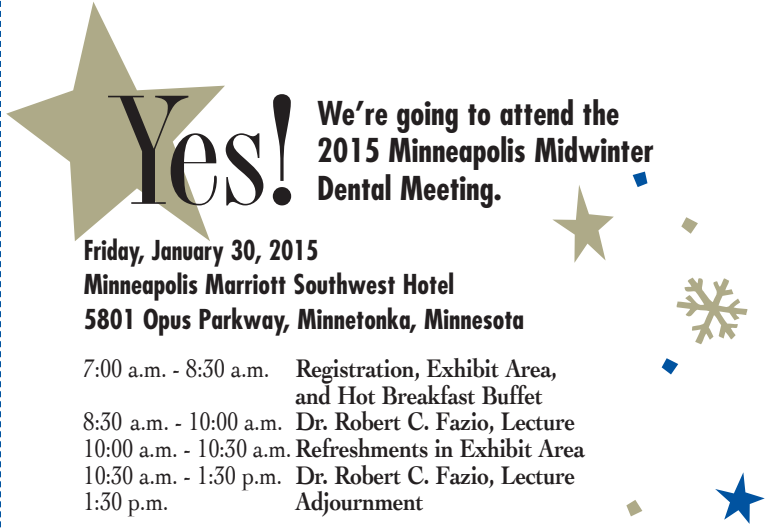

Robert C. Fazio, D.M.D.

Dr. Robert C. Fazio is an Associate Clinical Professor of Surgery at Yale University School of Medicine. He is a graduate of Harvard College and the Harvard School of Dental Medicine with advanced degrees in periodontology and oral medicine. He maintains a private practice in periodontology, implants and oral medicine in Norwalk, Connecticut. His current book, co-authored with Dr. Leslie Fang, is the 2014 Edition of *The Ultimate Cheat Sheets – The Practical Guide for Dentists*. It has been named by Gordon Christianson's CRA Newsletter: "Best Educational Product" for three consecutive years. He serves on the Editorial Board for *Inside Dentistry* and *Compendium of Continuing Education in Dentistry*.

Antibiotics in Dentistry

This course is for the entire dental team. It will discuss the changing antibiotic options in dentistry for acute infections and prophylaxis for old and new antibiotic categories and formulations. The current American Heart Association at-risk patients and the inconsistencies for the *ADA/Orthopedic Surgeons' 2012* recommendations will be discussed. As well as the following questions will be answered and discussed along with much more. What is recommended for patients already on, or recently on an antibiotic? New data and designs dictate a new approach to cardiac and vascular stents. What medical conditions affect antibiotic selection?

Educational Learning Objectives

- What role does the front desk personnel, the dental assistant and hygienist play in successful patient care?
- Develop algorithms for selecting antibiotics for localized and spreading infection and for antibiotic prophylaxis.
- Understand the subtleties of the AHA "Guidelines" and the inconsistencies of the *2012 ADA/AAOS Prosthetic Joint Recommendations*.
- Understand the new approach to antibiotic prophylaxis for stents, the four approaches to dialysis and a myriad of other medical devices.
- How does the four major drugs for anticoagulation therapy, pregnancy, the nursing mother, immunosuppressive therapy, and diabetes mellitus affect anti-biotic selection?

After Break Lecture

Periodontitis and Peri-Implantitis: The Good, the Bad and the Ugly

These questions along with many more will be answered during this very informative educational course: What must the dental team know chairside every day to successfully treat periodontitis in both the compliant and non-compliant patient? Do the same principles apply to peri-implantitis? How do we treatment plan a choice between periodontally compromised teeth, crown and bridge replacements or implants? Understand the evidence based data in the dental literature compared to the "promotional dentistry" of the manufacturers. Does the soft tissue program in the dental office influence this decision? Which cases are the winners and losers? What medical issues increase risk for dental failure? Learn specific protocols from currettes to toothbrushes, antibiotics to analgesics, medical disease and drugs, to mouth rinses and toothpaste.
