"We rocked it out" is an apt description of how teams at 176 Minnesota dental clinics responded to the equally heartwarming and hectic days of Give Kids a Smile on Feb. 7 and 8.

The description was provided by Shawna McNamara, who coordinated Metro Dentalcare Richfield's event. She explained that, despite some lastminute staff illnesses, a large team scrambled to provide free treatment to 41 children. Even short handed, they saw more children than last year and increased the value of services by \$10,000.

Thousands of children benefitted from the generosity of the dental community. And parents and patients were grateful.

Impact of GKAS extends beyond clinical work

At the heart of Give Kids a Smile is the restoration of dental health – and happy smiles – to children who don't have access to care. But, as one of MDA's annual charitable events, it also creates a valuable forum for discussing a wide range of dental health issues.

In each of the program's 12 years, media outreach through interviews and advertising has allowed MDA spokespersons to inform Minnesotans about important topics.

During her in-studio interview at WDIO-TV in Duluth, Kara Conry, DDS,

talked about her clinic's participation in Give Kids a Smile, while weaving in messages about the state's low reimbursement rates for dentists, the importance of creating a positive dental experience for children, and her joy of service to the community. In addition, Conry appeared on KBJR-TV and Iron Range 12.

Her colleagues across the state also took time from their clinical work to visit with reporters. Teresa Fong, DDS, was featured on WCCO-TV and KARE-11, as well as Comcast Cable TV.


