Lee Ann Brady, D.M.D.

Lee Ann Brady, D.M.D. is a private practicing dentist and nationally recognized educator, lecturer and author. She has extensive history in leadership, as Executive Vice President of Clinical

Education for Spear Education and Clinical Director of the Pankey Institute. She is currently the Director of Education for Clinical Mastery. She practices in Glendale, Arizona, and is a member of the editorial board of the Journal of Cosmetic Dentistry, Inside Dentistry and Dentaltown Magazine.

Course Overview

Dentistry is changing at a rapid pace. Being successful and efficient is about staying on top of the newest trends and clinical tips and Dr. Brady will present some of these. Some are old tried and true approaches that remain successful, while others introduce brand new materials and approaches.

Educational Learning Objectives

•**Caries Prevention:** Despite hopeful predictions that the caries rate would decrease and we might potentially eliminate caries in the United States, most clinicians feel they see more caries today than in the late 1980's to early 1990's. Older adult caries numbers are on the rise, and many of us have patients who have worked to maintain their oral health throughout their lives and now deal with new decay that puts their teeth at risk. Also, we will discuss the differences between xerostomia and dry mouth, how to assess this, and the role of medications in oral health.

•**Perio-Prevention:** We will discuss some new understandings of the causes and biology of periodontal disease, and how it differs from gingivitis. You will learn some easy at-home techniques patients can use to manage their periodontal condition. New oral rinses from topical anti-oxidants to probiotics will be discussed as well as existing modalities like chlorhexidine mouthwashes and antibiotic therapy.

•**Posterior Composite Efficiency and Effectiveness:** Posterior composite restorations for many dental practices are the mainstay of their daily routine. Issues from open contacts to ongoing sensitivity will be looked at. We will take a comprehensive look at

currently available techniques and matrix systems for creating predictably tight contacts. In addition, we will discuss tools for using ring systems, placing sectional matrix bands and different wedges that are currently available. We will look at the newer bulk fill composites, discuss the science behind their evolution, and when and where to use them.

•**Sensitivity:** Sensitivity is still a common issue in the dental office whether the patient is in the hygiene chair, or has just had a restorative procedure. We will discuss the causes of tooth sensitivity and how to differentiate them and then look at options available to manage or eliminate sensitivity.

•**Bleaching:** It's impossible to discuss tooth sensitivity without a conversation of bleaching. The mechanism of action of tooth bleaching is poorly understood, and therefore both dental professionals and patients are getting poor results. We will discuss how peroxide works to lighten the color of teeth, the difference between whitening and bleaching, and how to manage sensitivity during this process.

•**Successful Bonding & Cementation:** In this section we will discuss the difference between bonding and cementation. Today we have an unbelievable number of choices for materials. You will learn the process behind each category of cement and bonding process, when they are most appropriate clinically and some technique steps to create predictability.

•**Improved Posterior All Ceramic Restorations:** When we left doing gold restorations routinely behind we moved into a world of full coverage versus partial coverage. With the multiple selection today of durable ceramic systems available for posterior teeth, partial coverage has become a viable solution that allows us to conserve tooth structure.
