Opioid abuse, misuse and diversion continue to be serious problems in Minnesota. We will review the current regulations and protocols along with prescription dispensing guidelines. Plus, with the Minnesota Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) in place there are regulations that impact dental licensees. We will review all the requirements behind the law and how you can use your PMP account as a beneficial clinical tool.

We will discuss some current public disciplinary orders and corrective action agreements and look at common infractions in practice and how to proactively address them. We will also discuss rule and law changes that affect allied dental professional scope and delegation. The session will allow attendees to ask questions and engage on these very important issues.
