Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery At a Level 1 Trauma Center

He is a Former Director in the Advanced Education Program for Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the University of Minnesota.

Course Description

This course will focus on cases seen and treated in a Level 1 Trauma Center and managed by Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Though mainly focused on trauma, this talk will also discuss the pathological and reconstructive cases seen and treated there. Technological advances have changed and improved the care for these patients from computer aided treatment planning to titanium printed plates including stereo lithography. A variety of cases will be presented from initial presentation through treatment and completion.

This is a unique opportunity to see the other side of the dental specialty of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Many of these cases are referred from other specialists within the profession.
