“A new approach to treating dental disease and rebuilding teeth as seen through the eyes of a Hygienist and Dentist”

Course instructors: Frank J. Milner DDS, AAACD and Dianne Testa RDH, BSDH

This course is designed to help you think differently about how teeth are built and their appearance in relationship to the oral environment. Your journey starts with how the restoration appears. Then, progressing how the tooth was damaged, forward to the first signs of demineralization, and finishing with rebuilding healthy tooth structure. Along this journey, you will be taught which restorative material is compatible with tooth structure; expansion and contraction of the enamel and the restoration material. You will be instructed about materials that are suitable for dentin replacement. You will look at how to maintain the tooth in its natural state. How acid damages teeth and what can be done to prevent that damage will be discussed. Understanding the role of testing saliva and using this as part of diagnosing of future decay is an important feature of this course. Risk factors and how they affect the patient’s overall dental health will be discussed as well.

The hands on section of the course will prove to be both exciting and stimulating. You will be working with corresponding dental materials and the proper assessment of products. The whole team will benefit from the course because it centers on the team approach to diagnosing. The over all goal of the dental team is to help our patients maintain their teeth, reduce recurrent decay and new decay. This course will give you the knowledge, the protocols, the risk assessment forms, and the hands on practice so you can put what you have learned into action immediately.

Learn the importance of dentin substitution
Create natural appearing restoration with a next generation composite system
Understand the role of saliva pH
Utilize risk assessment tools for the diagnosing of future dental diseases
