APO Enforcement Program

Authorized By Statute (MS 144.989 to 144.993)

"Health Enforcement Consolidation Act"

Purpose:

 Serves to clearly inform the regulated industry of the requirements and consequences of violations

AND

Provides a deterrence to future non-compliance.

MDH Enforcement Program

- Routine x-ray inspection reports are given:
 - 30 days to correct violations or
 - Provide MDH a plan for correction.
 - Failure to respond to MDH can result in an Administrative Penalty Order.
- MDH does send letters to the facility with each step that's taken to an APO forum.

APO Enforcement Program

A radiation inspection begins by having found violations that are:

Serious or

Serious with same repeated violations or

Repeated serious violations or

Non-compliance of an inspection report with above issues.

-This can start the APO Plan Process

APO Enforcement Plan

- APO process gives the facility:
 - 10 days to dispute the information
 - 30 days to correct violations or provide a plan for APO correction of the inspection report violations.
 - If no response the next step starts...a forum is formed.

APO Enforcement Program

In the forum, participants discuss the issues;

All decisions are always made by a forum;

All decisions must follow the APO Plan!

Penalties can be:

- forgivable or
- non-forgivable or
- a combination of both

APO Options for Facility

- Come into compliance
- Pay the fine
- Begin to start compliance by knowing the Requirements, Rules, Statutes and having a solid Quality Assurance Program (Radiation Safety Program) and an RSO and Staff that are committed to being compliant.
