2025 EVENT RECAP

Thank you to all the volunteers for graciously donating their time and skills towards providing healthy smiles to so many children in Minnesota. In all, 1,245 children statewide received care from 48 hosting clinics, 154 dentists, and 969 total volunteers. This care is valued at over \$855,000*. The MDA was grateful to receive funding from longtime dedicated sponsors Solventum (formerly 3M) and the Minnesota Dental Foundation. Their involvement allowed us to provide a solid statewide marketing campaign.

We teamed up with KMSP-TV for the 2025 ad campaign. They





broadcast a total of 247 Give Kids a Smile commercials on Fox 9 and Fox 9+. We received 2.7 million household impressions between the two channels. Give Kids a Smile also hit the airways by way of radio. Eight outstate stations aired a total of 494 commercials. A Facebook campaign was organized, receiving over 1.4 million impressions.
